Olivier Savin, 45, is a Business School graduate (1989) completed by a Management and Finance MBA (1990).

After several positions in foreign countries, he joined the Safran group in 1992 and started at Messier Services as finance & control manager, then sales manager, before being named head of MRO marketing, and then head of international joint ventures and subsidiaries.

In 1998 he moved to Snecma Services, where he was named general manager of Snecma Morocco Engine Services (CFM56 maintenance, repair and overhaul new joint venture in Casablanca between Snecma & Royal Air Maroc).

In 2002 he became general manager of the Snecma Services engines repair & overhaul plant in Châtelleraut, then head of the company's Repairs business unit.

Olivier Savin joined CFM International (the 50/50 joint company of Safran and GE) in 2008, as Executive Vice President, in charge of the CFM56 and LEAP programs.
